The Current Plan: For each level split we will start with HD. Then, Interior, Exterior, Buried, Containers.

But What Time Will My Class Start?

We get a lot of questions on "when will my class start" for trials. We cannot give out times other than the start of the first class of the day. However, here is a way for you to estimate when your class MAY start running:

In the Regulations for AKC Scent Work (on the AKC website under "Scent Work" "Regulations Resources"), page 18 under Chapter 3 Section 22 it lists an estimated time per entry per class/level.

Above, we give entry counts as of the pre-entry closing along with the order the classes will run.

You can multiply out the estimated judging time per run x the entries in each class to get a rough estimate. However, please note that this doesn't include absent dogs, move-ups, day-of-show/late entries, judge breaks, lunch breaks, etc. And runs don't always last the "estimated" judging time per run. There are no refunds/credits/moves for missed runs. Calculate at your own risk!

Text Message Alerts:

Receive informational text messages regarding Front Range Scent Work Trials! (Including what classes we are currently building/running.)

- o You will receive a text message asking to provide your full name.

Directions: Head North on \$ 48th Street W toward Neibauer Road. Turn Right onto Neibauer Road and MT-302/Shiloh Road to Hesper Road. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto Hesper Road. Turn Left on Gabel Road. Turn Left onto Grant Road.

Directions to the Trial Site:

From I-90 West

Take Zoo Drive exit 443. Keep right to take the ramp towards Shiloh Road. Turn right onto Zoo Drive. Enter roundabout and take the 2nd exit onto S Shiloh Road. Shiloh Road becomes Neibauer Road. Turn left onto S 48th St W. Billings K9 Coaching is on the left. You'll need to drive through Mountain West Storage to the back of the lot. A gate code for access will be provided before the trials.

From I-90 East

Take Frontage Road S exit 437. Turn right onto S Frontage Road. Turn left onto S 56th St W. Take the 1st right onto Danford Road. Take the 3rd left onto Danford Drive. Turn left onto S 48th St W. Billings K9 Coaching is on the left. You'll need to drive through Mountain West Storage to the back of the lot. A gate code for access will be provided before the trials.
