

Front Range Scent Work Club AKC Scent Work Trials March 5-6-7, 2021

Location:

Hughes Supply, 1610 Vista View Dr, Longmont, CO 80504 See back page for map.

We will be using the outdoor fenced yard along with the office and warehouse sections of the building. Check in area will be through the main entrance in the lobby or just outside those doors depending on weather. Please do not bring dogs into the front lobby unless you are on your way to a search area.

Please be sure to read any posted signs for important information!

Parking/Crating:

If you plan on idling your car, do not park in the spots up against the building. You will be asked to move. There is also street parking available. Last time we were also able to park in the lot across the street.

DO NOT PARK IN THE NEIGHBORING PARKING LOT TO THE WEST OF THE BUILDING. This business is open during the weekend. If you see anyone over there please help us out and let them know that they shouldn't be parked there. We do not want Hughes receiving complaints!

Due to COVID and space restrictions, crating will be out of your vehicles. Bring shades, fans, heaters, etc. No electricity will be provided. Canopies may be able to be set up depending on space, be sure to not block vehicle access. Please practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines and avoid congregating to the extent possible.

Schedule:

Friday:

4:30pm - Check-in (Please do not arrive earlier than this as the business is open until 4:30.)

4:45pm - Briefing

5:00pm - Start of HD, followed by Container and then Buried (run back to back). Detective will start after those runs are done (estimated around 5:45pm).

Saturday/Sunday:

8:30am- Check-in starts (You do not need to arrive first thing in the morning to check in.) 9:00am – Briefing, first dog to follow.

Lunch is estimated to be after Master/Excellent completed. Other breaks may be taken at the judge's and/or club's discretion.

Running Order:

The exact running order will be fluid and dependent on weather, conflicts, worker dogs, etc. Pre-entry counts are listed below. Please try not to arrive super early unless you plan on volunteering. We are trying to limit the number of people/cars.

Current Plan:

Maureen is judging HD, Buried, and Exterior. Sharon is judging Interior and Container. Judges will be running dogs at the same time in different areas.

We will be running BY LEVEL, with the exception of some HD dogs that are in a lower level HD class versus their regular class runs (see note below). If you are running multiple dogs and you aren't sure where to go first, ask!

Exterior and Buried will be run together. Interior and Containers will be run together. You'll run one set and then have a break before the other. If you need a break between your two runs in a set, just let us know.

Dogs WILL get to run HD before being on odor as long as you give us advance notice. If you are in a lower level for HD then your other classes just let us know EARLY. For example, if you are in Master Buried, but Advanced HD, let us know and we will run you in Advanced HD before you run your Master runs.*

Master HD, then all Master classes.

Then... Excellent HD, then all Excellent classes.

Then LUNCH.

After lunch, Advanced HD, then all Advanced classes.

Then... Novice HD, then all Novice classes. Novice A & B will be mixed.

Wait-List & Pulled Entries:

There is currently a waitlist for these trials. See the premium for refund policies.

Absent dogs <u>must be declared</u> in order for spots to be eligible to be filled by the waitlist. We will not pull dogs from the trial without notice being given in writing.

But What Time Will My Class Start?

We get a lot of questions on "when will my class start" for trials. We cannot give out times other than the start of the first class of the day. However, here is a way for you to estimate when your class MAY start running:

In the Regulations for AKC Scent Work (on the AKC website under "Scent Work" "Regulations Resources"), page 18 under Chapter 3 Section 22 it lists an estimated time per entry per class/level.

Above, we give entry counts as of the pre-entry closing along with the order the classes will run.

You can multiply out the estimated judging time per run x the entries in each class to get a rough estimate. However, please note that this doesn't include absent dogs, move-ups, day-of-show/late entries, judge breaks, lunch breaks, etc. And runs don't always last the "estimated" judging time per run. There are no refunds/credits/moves for missed runs. Calculate at your own risk!

Text Message Alerts:

Receive informational text messages regarding Front Range Scent Work Trials! (Including what classes we are currently building/running.)

Text "@FRSWC-0321" (everything within the quotes, including the @) to the number 81010.

- You will receive a text message asking to provide your full name.
- o If asked "Are you a teacher, parent, or student" text reply "S" for student.
- o Then your phone will receive text messages of interest during the event.

You do NOT have to download or utilize the software link suggested to receive our text messages on your phone!

*This text messaging system is primarily used by educators, so it may reference "classes", "teachers", and/or "students".

Miscellaneous Notes:

The buildings are climate controlled but there is no indoor crating available. Please be sure to not block business customer access with your vehicles / set-up.

Water is available but if you can please bring water jugs for dog water.

Dogs must be kept on lead in keeping with the leash laws. Please also remember to respect other people's property!

Pottying: There is some grass areas outside the building. Please do not potty dogs in the small grassy landscaped area to the west of the building. Please do not hang out or set up chairs/tents in that area. Pay attention to marked areas so you aren't walking into a search area. Please be sure to pick up after your dog. Please keep your dog from peeing on the side of the building, or on any items that people have to pick up! Please clean up any accidents in the building immediately.

Food/Drinks: There are plenty of shops nearby for eating.

Bathrooms: There are bathrooms on site.
